MEASURE	DESCRIPTION AND HOW IT WAS CALCULATED
Graduation Rate for Bachelor Degrees	We are taking the number of students who started their program in the University 3.5 – 4 years ago and divide it by the number of graduates within this cohort. Graduates included are those who completed within 150% of the program length.
Graduation Rate for Master Degrees	We are taking the number of students who started their program in the University 1.5 - 2 years ago and divide it by the number of graduates within this cohort. Graduates included are those who completed within 150% of the program length.
Graduation Rate for Doctorate Degrees	We are taking the number of students who started their program in the University 3 – 3.5 years ago and divide it by the number of graduates within this cohort. Graduates included are those who completed within 150% of the program length.
